

**Samuel Johnson, M.D. – Executive Director of Medical Affairs**

Dr. Johnson joined Houston as Executive Director of Medical Affairs in June 2007. In this position, he serves as an advisor and liaison to the medical staffs and Chiefs of Staff of Houston Medical Center and Perry Hospital.
