Requirement criteria for Monoclonal Antibody Clinic

- Must have COVID-19 positive test result in hand.
- Must have identification (and insurance card, if applicable)

And either be:

Must be 60 years of age or older, and weigh at least 88 lbs.

Patient must additionally meet three of the following:

- (BMI) \geq 30
- Pneumonia diagnosis
- Chronic kidney disease
- Diabetes
- Immunosuppressive disease or immunosuppressive treatment
- Cardiovascular disease (including congenital heart disease) or hypertension
- Chronic lung disease (e.g., chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, moderate-to-severe asthma, interstitial lung disease, cystic fibrosis, pulmonary hypertension)
- Sickle cell disease
- Neurodevelopmental disorders (e.g., cerebral palsy) or other conditions that confer medical complexity (e.g., genetic or metabolic syndromes, severe congenital anomalies)
- Medical-related technological dependence (e.g., tracheostomy, gastrostomy, positive pressure ventilation not related to COVID-19).

No age requirement, and weigh at least 88 lbs.

Patient must additionally meet one of the following conditions:

- An organ transplant patient on anti-rejection medications
- An active chemotherapy patient.
